DATA PROTECTION PRINCIPLES

1. Data Controller

1.1. Data Controller is the Swedish Civil Defence and Resilience Agency.

2. Data processing legal basis and purposes

2.1. The legal basis for the processing of personal data is the performance of a contract (according to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) article 6 paragraph 1 point b). The Swedish civil defence and resilience agency processes personal data in connection with registration for the authority's conferences or seminars. The processing is carried out to administer the registration and to follow up on the authority's conferences or seminars. The legal basis for the administration of the registration is the performance of the contract concluded in connection with the registration. The legal basis for the processing carried out in connection with the follow-up is the performance of a task carried out in the public interest. During this event, we collect personal data only for the purpose of organizing this event and any potential follow-up.

2.2. The event will be photographed. Only individuals whose role requires them to appear in images within the relevant context will be photographed. Otherwise, identifiable individuals will not be shown in any photos. We have included the relevant information on the event website, in the registration form, and in these data protection principles.

3. Collected Personal Data

3.1. The personal data collected includes the participant's name, contact information (e-mail address, phone number), organisation, the organisation's domicile, dietary restrictions or allergies and comments.

4. Data Retention

4.1. Personal data collected will be deleted once the purposes of the processing have been fulfilled. Personal data will be stored for 365 days unless otherwise stated at the time of registration.

5. Photographer and Recording

5.1. Please note that the event will be photographed and that these photos may be published on LinkedIn and/or the NCC-SE website. Only individuals whose role requires them to appear in images within the relevant context will be photographed. In all other cases, identifiable individuals will not be shown in any photos.

6. Data Subjects Rights

6.1. As a data subject, you have the right to request access, rectification, objection, restriction of processing, erasure, and data portability of your personal data. If you, as a data subject registered with the Swedish Civil Defence Agency, wish to exercise your rights or have questions regarding the agency's processing of your personal data, you may contact the agency's Data Protection Officer at dso@mcf.se.

7. Data Sharing

7.1. Personal data collected during the event will be shared with the co-organizing institutions: National Cybersecurity Coordination Centre of Finland (NCC-FI) and National Cybersecurity Coordination Centre of Estonia (NCC-EE) for the purposes of coordinating this event.
